Notes re Application for Membership

Class of Membership

Ordinary: Members (aged 18 & over) who have full rights and privileges of Membership.

Associate: Members (aged 18 & over) who may use the Club and its facilities, except that they may not moor a boat in the harbour or store one in the yard. Nor may they vote at any General Meeting. Associate members resident outside mainland Scotland or overseas may elect to pay an Associate (Out of Port) or Associate (Overseas) subscription. Student members 18 years of age and over in full time education with a current matriculation card may apply for Associate membership.

Cadet: Members under 18 years of age who may use the Club and its facilities except they may not purchase or consume alcohol on the premises.

Family: Membership covers Ordinary membership for the applicant, Associate membership for the applicant's spouse/partner and Cadet membership for each child up to their 18th birthday.

Occupation

If you are retired enter "Retired" and state your occupation previous to retirement.

Address

The address you give must be that at which the applicant normally resides (care of and/or company addresses are not acceptable).

Payment

Payment should accompany your application. Your cheque will not be negotiated until you have become a member.
